

City of Murphysboro, IL POLICE OFFICER

- CITIZENSHIP:** Applicant must be a United States Citizen.
- AGE:** Applicant must be between 20 and 34 years of age, age limitations do not apply to any person who has been previously employed as a full-time Police Officer.
- Veterans can exceed the maximum age requirement by the number of years served on active duty, but no more than 10 years (please submit Military DD214 form).
- EDUCATION:** Applicant must possess a High School Diploma or a GED certificate,
- REQUIREMENTS:** Applicant must qualify medically, possess a valid driver's license, and must be of good moral character. Upon appointment the applicant must and shall serve a one (1) year probationary period.
- SELECTION PROCESS:** The selection process will include application review and acceptance by the Board of Fire & Police Commissioners. Then a Physical Agility Test, Written Examination, Background Investigation, and Oral Interview will establish the Eligibility List.
- SALARY:** Police – Pre-PTI Training - \$32,456.00/yr
Post-PTI Training - \$39,345.00/yr
After 1 year - \$40,894.00/yr
- LATERAL TRANSFERS:** Applicant must pass a Background Investigation and Oral Interview. Must be certified as a Police Officer in the State of Illinois or eligible for a waiver of certification in the State of Illinois. Beginning salary will be at the Post-PTI rate.
