

**Murphysboro Special City Council Meeting  
November 26, 2012**

The Murphysboro, Illinois, City Council met in special session, pursuant to its ordinances, on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2012. Mayor Pro Tem Bill Pierson called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and Alderman Hughes led the council in prayer. Following the invocation, Mayor Pro Tem Pierson led the council in the pledge of allegiance to the flag. Mayor Pro Tem Pierson then directed City Clerk Cottonaro to call the roll. We have now solicited bids for the south sidewalks and wall; later we will solicit for the east sidewalk and wall and the north sidewalk and wall. Bids are as follows: Flow Line-total of \$22,014- sidewalk at \$14,064, wall at \$7,950; Samron-total of \$20,300-sidewalk at \$14,200, wall at \$6,100.

Alderman McComb made a motion to accept Samron's bid in the amount of \$20,300. There was no second to the motion, motion died.
