The Murphysboro, Illinois, City Council met in regular session, pursuant to its ordinances, on the 10th day of May 2016. Mayor Stephens called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and pastor Frye led the council in prayer. Following the invocation, Mayor Stephens led the council in the pledge of allegiance to the flag. Mr. Joe Fry with the Park District discussed the MYRC building. He stated that the city had agreed to do some roof repair work on the loading dock area and pay the bill. The loading dock area is the city's exclusively and MYRC is not involved in the use of that area. Additionally there are other roof repairs. The Park District thought we were doing the roof repair and paying for it prior to their tenancy, not that they had to pay one half of the bill. It was determined we would discuss when we get the bill. They also request that if we do repairs to the building and if they have to pay they want to know so they can plan for it. Council thinks this is a reasonable request.

Attorney Heller stated that he could not. The city cannot pay for the improvement of private property. Attorney Heller stated that if the wall was built to correct a problem it is their obligation to pay bill.
